Activities Remaining

- The subcommittee recognizes there are number of interdependent steps that must occur in order to transition to NG9-1-1. However, exact dates and timelines are difficult to predict given the number of technical, operational and economic variables among multiple entities including industry, public safety, policymakers and consumers.
