## STATEMENT FROM FCC CHAIRMAN JULIUS GENACHOWSKI ON SENATOR ROCKEFELLER RETIREMENT ANNOUNCEMENT

Washington, D.C. – The following statement is attributable to FCC Chairman Julius Genachowski:
