NOTICE OF UNLICENSED OPERATION

The Los Angeles Office received information concerning an unlicensed C-Band satellite temporary uplink transmitter operating in Pasadena, California. On July 7, 2013, an agent from this office inspected the Televisa Satellite News Gathering (SNG) vehicle deployed for use during the 2013 CONCACAF Gold Cup soccer tournament located at the Rose Bowl in Pasadena. Televisa personnel stated during the inspection that this SNG vehicle transmitted in the C-Band (5.925 to 6.425 GHz) during the event, however, Televisa personnel could not produce an FCC license authorizing this operation. A review of the Commission's records shows that no license was issued to Televisa for this facility.

Radio stations must be licensed by the FCC pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 301. You are hereby warned that operation of radio transmitting equipment without a valid radio station authorization constitutes a violation of the Federal laws cited above and could subject the operator of this illegal operation to severe penalties, including, but not limited to, substantial monetary forfeitures, *in rem* arrest action against the offending radio equipment, and criminal sanctions including imprisonment. (*See* 47 U.S.C. §§ 401, 501, 503 and 510.)

UNLICENSED OPERATION OF THIS RADIO STATION MUST BE DISCONTINUED IMMEDIATELY.

You have ten (10) days from the date of this notice to respond with any evidence that you have authority to operate granted by the FCC. Your response should be sent to the address in the letterhead and reference the listed case and document number. Under the Privacy Act of 1974, 5 U.S.C. § 552a(e)(3), we are informing you that the Commission's staff will use all relevant material information before it to determine what, if any, enforcement action is required to ensure your compliance with FCC Rules. This will include any information that you disclose in your reply.
