Aloha. I am writing in regards to a Request for Waiver of Form 471 Filing Deadline for Funding year 2013-2014 submitted on September 22, 2013 (Billed Entity Number: 16043126, Form 471 Application Number: 909763, CC Docket No. 02-6) in response to an Administrative Decision issued by the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC).
