On June 11, 2014, Kathleen M. Grillo, Michael E. Glover, Chris Levendos and I from Verizon met with Commissioner Jessica Rosenworcel and Priscilla Delgado Argeris, legal advisor to Commissioner Rosenworcel and separately with Commissioner Michael O'Rielly and Amy Bender, legal advisor to Commissioner O'Rielly.

In the meetings we described the process we are using in the wire centers for which we have filed network modification notices to care for customers as we make the transition to fiber for the very small number of customers still on copper, including the provision of back up power. The discussions were consistent with prior submissions. ¹
