## **STATEMENT FROM FCC CHAIRMAN TOM WHEELER ON GIGABIT NETWORK DEVELOPMENT IN CONNECTICUT**

WASHINGTON-- Today Connecticut leaders announced they are seeking to develop ultra-high-speed gigabit Internet networks in three cities – New Haven, West Hartford and Stamford. The following is attributable to FCC Chairman Tom Wheeler.

“High-speed broadband is an essential asset for today’s communities and tomorrow’s economy. Too many Americans lack real choices for fast, affordable Internet service, which is why I’m heartened to see these leaders commit to bringing gigabit connectivity to the businesses and consumers of central Connecticut.
