Dear Congresswoman Matsui:

Thank you for your letter supporting a recent waiver request filed by KXPR. I appreciate the opportunity to respond.

As noted in your letter, California State University-Sacramento (CSU-S) filed a request on March 20, 2015, seeking a waiver of the three-year period for construction of its new tower and antenna facility. The original construction permit will expire on August 16, 2015, and CSU-S indicates it has experienced delays that will prevent completion of construction by the current deadline.

It is important to note that although the Commission does have the discretion to waive rules for good cause, such requests face a high hurdle and must be supported with a compelling showing. Please be assured that Commission staff will review CSU-S's request and give it due consideration as soon as possible.
