TECHNICAL FORMULAS FOR COMPETITIVE BIDDING

On October 15, 2015, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau released a Public Notice (*Auction 1000 Application Procedures Public Notice*), DA 15-1183, in the above-captioned proceedings. See 30 FCC Rcd 11034 (WTB 2015). This Erratum corrects Section 2.7 of Appendix C to the *Auction 1000 Application Procedures Public Notice* regarding the constraints used in the quaternary clearing target optimization as well as corrects Sections 4 and 9 of Appendix G to the *Auction 1000 Application Procedures Public Notice* regarding when a bidder may submit switch bids and how next round bidder eligibility is calculated after an extended round, as indicated below. Updated versions of Appendix C and Appendix G can be found in the Documents section of the Auction 1001 website (www.fcc.gov/auctions/1001) and in the Documents section of the Auction 1002 website (www.fcc.gov/auctions/1002).

In Appendix C:

1. In Section 2.7, the first sentence of the second paragraph is corrected to read as follows:

“In this optimization, all stations assigned in the 600 MHz Band above *HC* + 1 will remain on their assigned channel, and no additional stations will be assigned to the 600 MHz Band.”

In Appendix G:

2. In Section 4.1, a new eighth paragraph is added and the now ninth paragraph is corrected to read as follows:

“A bidder may *not* submit two switch bids with the same ‘from’ product and different ‘to’ products in the same round.¹

A bidder may *not* submit two different bids that involve the same product at the same price. For example, the bidder cannot submit a simple bid for 2 blocks of product A and a simple bid for 0 blocks of product A both at the same price. Similarly, if A and B are products in the same PEA, the bidder cannot submit a bid to switch one block from A to B and another bid to switch two blocks from A to B both at the same price.²”

3. In the newly added paragraph, at the end, a new footnote number “1” is added and the remaining footnotes are renumbered accordingly.

4. The text of the new footnote 1 is added to read as follows:

“¹However, a bidder may submit two switch bids with the same ‘to’ product and different ‘from’ products in the same round.”

5. In Section 4.1.1, in the first bullet below the second paragraph, replace “to” with “from”.

6. In Section 9.1, the section heading is corrected to read as follows:

“9.1 Next Round Eligibility – After a Regular Clock Round and After an Extended Round in Which the Final Stage Rule Was Met”

7. In the first sentence, replace “After any regular clock round” with “In most cases, after round”.

8. In Section 9.2, the section heading is corrected to read as follows:

“9.2 Next Round Eligibility – After an Extended Round in Which the Final Stage Rule Was Not Met”

9. Below the first paragraph, correct the formula to read as follows:

$$\text{“min}\left(\textit{Eligibility}(t), \sum_{r \in ER} d_{i,r} \cdot b_r + \frac{1}{\textit{Activity Requirement}} \sum_{r \notin ER} d_{i,r} \cdot b_r\right)\text{”}$$

10. In the third bullet, at the end, replace “(see Section 3.2)” with “(see Section 3.2 of this Appendix)”.

11. A fourth bullet is added to read as follows:

“- t denotes the extended round and thus $\textit{Eligibility}(t)$ is the bidder’s eligibility in the extended round.”

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
