Upon consideration of the emergency petition for a writ of mandamus, the opposition thereto, and the reply, it is

ORDERED that the petition be denied. Under the circumstances presented here, petitioner has not shown the Federal Communication Commission's delay to be so unreasonable as to warrant the extraordinary remedy of mandamus. See In re Monroe Commc'n Corp., 840 F.2d 942 (D.C. Cir. 1988); Telecomm. Research & Action Ctr. v. FCC, 750 F.2d 70 (D.C. Cir. 1984). Based on the agency's representations, the Court expects the Commission to rule on the pending reconsideration petition "before the start of the incentive auction on March 29, 2016[.]" FCC Opposition at 15.
