
Dear Chairman Wheeler,

We write to request that the Commission take action on a long-pending petition concerning the renewal of KUFW-FM, a station based in Woodlake, California. This is a matter of great concern to us and to our constituents, including Gerawan Farming, which is one of the nation's largest fruit growers and one of the largest employers in California's San Joaquin Valley.

On October 31, 2013, Gerawan filed a petition with your agency that outlined violations of KUFW-FM's non-commercial broadcast license. Gerawan highlighted dozens of examples of commercial advertisements broadcast on KUFW-FM. Subsequent filings by Gerawan demonstrate that KUFW-FM has continued running these commercials, suggesting a deliberate violation of FCC rules and regulations. The FCC has previously sanctioned the station (or its parent organization) for a similar violation.

Seeing as this matter has languished for nearly two and a half years, we urge you to promptly make a decision on Gerawan's petition.


