Class of Station:

SES Americom, Inc. requests special temporary authority for a period of 180 days to operate its fixed earth station in Mount Airy, MD to provide telemetry, tracking and command (TT&C) to the ASTRA 3A satellite, as it relocates from its current location of 86.85° W.L. to 47.0° W.L., on the following center frequencies: 14499 MHz (Earth-to-space), and 11450.25 MHz and 11699.50 MHz (space-to-Earth).
