Special Temporary Authority

Intelsat License LLC requests special temporary authority for a period of 90 days to conduct in-orbit testing (IOT) of the Intelsat 35e satellite at the 33.0° W.L. orbital location using the 3625-4200 MHz, 10.95-11.2 GHz, and 11.45-11.7 GHz (space-to-Earth); and 5850-6425 MHz, 13.75-14.0 GHz, and 14.0-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands. Intelsat also requests authority to conduct telemetry, tracking, and command operations necessary to maintain Intelsat 35e during IOT at the 33.0° W.L. orbital location, and to effect the drift of Intelsat 35e to the 34.5° W.L. orbital location upon completion of IOT, using the following center frequencies: 4197.75 MHz, 4198.25 MHz, 4198.75 MHz, and 4199.25 MHz (space-to-Earth); and 5853.0 MHz and 6424.5 MHz (Earth-to-space).
