2017-2018 Contribution Factor

Dear Ms. Monteith:

This is to advise the Federal Communications Commission that the North American Numbering Council ("NANC"), at its June 29, 2017 meeting, concurred without dissent with the recommendation of the Billing and Collection Working Group to approve the FY 2017-2018 North American Numbering Plan ("NANP") Fund Contribution Factor at **0.0000518**. The Billing and Collection Working Group has based this recommendation on the preliminary revenue data estimate of \$144.9B from the Universal Service Administrative Company. The total FY 2017-2018 NANP Budgeted Expenses are projected to amount to \$8,032,418. The anticipated surplus from the FY 2016-2017 budget is \$384,920 which will be applied to the FY 2017-2018 budget requirement. Contributions from international NANP participants will amount to \$141,025 for FY 2017-2018. The US contributions for FY 2017-2018 will amount to \$7,506,473. The FY 2017-2018 NANP Budget includes a contingency allowance of \$1,000,000.
