Special Temporary Authority

Intelsat License LLC requests special temporary authority for a period of 180 days to (1) conduct telemetry, tracking, and command operations necessary to drift the Intelsat 5 space station to, and maintain the space station at, the 137.0° W.L. orbital location, and (2) provide fixed-satellite service from the 137.0° W.L. orbital location in the 3700-4200 MHz (space-to-Earth), 5925-6425 MHz (Earth-to-space), 11.45-11.7 GHz (space-to-Earth), and 14.0-14.25 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands.
