ORDER

Upon consideration of the letter filed September 10, 2018, by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"), and the responsive letter filed September 12, 2018, it is

ORDERED that this petition for writ of mandamus be dismissed as moot. Petitioners Competitive Enterprise Institute, et al., ("CEI") asked this court to issue a writ compelling the FCC to enter an order granting or denying CEI's petition for reconsideration. The FCC has now advised the court that it has adopted and released an order dismissing CEI's petition for reconsideration. *See Applications of Charter Communications, Inc., Time Warner Cable Inc., and Advance/Charter Newhouse Partnership For Consent to Assign or Transfer Control of Licenses and Authorizations, Order on Reconsideration*, FCC 18-127 (released Sept. 10, 2018). Accordingly, all the parties agree that the petition for writ of mandamus is moot, as does the court.
