Carr Thanks Senate and Congratulates Geoffrey Starks on Confirmation

WASHINGTON, January 3, 2019—FCC Commissioner Brendan Carr released the following statement after the U.S. Senate confirmed Carr to a new, five-year term and confirmed Geoffrey Starks to serve as an FCC Commissioner:
