CHAIRMAN PAI STATEMENT ON RESIGNATION OF DAVID REDL AS NTIA ADMINISTRATOR

WASHINGTON, May 9, 2019—Federal Communications Commission Chairman Ajit Pai released the following statement regarding the resignation of David Redl, who was the Administrator of the National Telecommunications and Information Administration in the Department of Commerce and Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Communications and Information:

He was a vocal advocate within the Department of Commerce for repurposing federal spectrum for commercial use and fostering the private sector's lead in 5G deployment.
