Modification

DIRECTV Enterprises, LLC, requests a modification of its operating authority for the T16 space station to: (1) change its authorized orbital location from 102.70° W.L. to 100.85° W.L.; and (2) to provide Direct Broadcast Satellite service using the 12.2-12.7 GHz (space-to-Earth) and 17.3-17.8 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands. T16 is currently authorized to use the 17.3-17.7 GHz, 18.3-18.59 GHz and 19.7-20.2 GHz (space-to-Earth), and 24.75-25.15 GHz, 28.35-28.6 GHz, 29.25-29.29 GHz, and 29.5-30 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands. Telemetry, tracking, and command will use the 12698.0 MHz and 12697.0 MHz (space-to-Earth), and 17791.0 MHz and 17789.0 MHz (Earth-to-space) center frequencies.
