SES Americom, Inc. seeks to modify the license for its AMC-11 space station at the 131° W.L. orbital location by extending the license term to March 1, 2026. SES also requests a waiver of the orbital debris mitigation requirements in Section 25.283(c) of the Commission's rules. AMC-11 is authorized to provide fixed satellite service in the 3700-4200 MHz (space-to-Earth) and 5925-6425 MHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands.
