
Dear Congressman Mullin:

Thank you for regarding the petition filed by Pineland Telephone Cooperative Inc. (Pineland) for reconsideration of the FCC's December 2018 Report and Order, which revised Alternative Connect America Model support for rural carriers to deploy high-speed broadband to high-cost areas. As you know, closing the digital divide is my top priority, and I am proud of the role that small, rural carriers play in accomplishing that goal.

The Commission's staff sought comment on Pineland's petition earlier this year, and the comment cycle on the matter has closed. Our staff are now carefully reviewing the record in the proceeding.
