Special Temporary Authority

DG Consents Sub, Inc. requests an extension of special temporary authority for a period of 180 days to conduct telemetry, tracking, and command and data downlink of Earth Exploration Satellite Service operations with its WorldView-4 space station (formerly known as GeoEye-2) at an orbital altitude between 425 kilometers and 525 kilometers, instead of its currently authorized altitude of 496 kilometers to 770 kilometers.
