In response to your December 16, 2019 letter,¹ attached is a report addressing interoperable video calling prepared by the North American Numbering Council's (NANC) Interoperable Video Calling (IVC) Working Group and adopted by the NANC. Pursuant to your request, the report provides recommendations for using a database approach to allow video calls to be placed or received with ten-digit telephone numbers on an interoperable basis. The report also examines the ability of Telecommunications Relay Services (TRS) users to interact with IVC for calls with other TRS users, non-TRS users, and to and from 9-1-1.

I would like to acknowledge and thank the leadership and members of the IVC Working Group for the great amount of time and effort that went into creating the report and recommendations.
