Silkwave Africa, LLC requests authority to relocate the Asiasat geostationary spacecraft from the 105° E.L. orbital location to the 21° E.L. orbital location and to operate the spacecraft at 21° E.L. in the 7025-7075 MHz (Earth-to-space) and 1452-1492 MHz (space-to-Earth) to provide Broadcast-Satellite Service.

Modification

Intelsat License LLC requests modification of the authorization for its Intelsat 904 space station at the 29.5° W.L. (330.5° E.L.) orbital location, in order to operate the satellite's beams over a new coverage area, using the 3625-4200 MHz (space-to-Earth) and 5850-6425 MHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands. Intelsat 904 also operates using Ku-band frequencies, but the Ku-band beams would be unaffected by this modification request.
