

Established regulatory framework and licensing process for the Next-Generation TV Standard



- 23 markets broadcasting now
- 20 television models with ATSC 3.0 tuners

Celebrated 100 years of radio while preparing for its future

- Simplified rules for FM NCE, LPFM and FM translators
- Revitalized AM Radio
 - Authorized 2,800 AM stations for FM translators
 - Permitted all-digital AM service on a voluntary basis

Media Regulation Modernization Initiative

- 22 Proceedings launched to establish rules consistent with the contemporary media marketplace
- 26 Orders updated regulations for the digital age
 - Revamped children's television programming rules
 - Eased cable leased access obligations
 - Eliminated various recordkeeping requirements
- Reduced entities' costs and burdens of compliance

Leveling the Playing Field

- Interpreted Cable Act to prohibit excessive regulation of cable operators by Franchising Authorities
- Interpreted Cable Act to recognize that streaming video services can provide effective competition to traditional cable services.

Initiated Media Ownership Reforms

- Eliminated newspaper-broadcast cross-ownership rule
- Eased local television ownership rule
- Created innovative incubator program

- Promoting small business entry into media industries

Evaluated Media Transactions

- Reviewed over 15,000 applications to assign or transfer broadcast licenses for compliance with the Act, our rules, and other applicable statutes
- Identified opportunities for new sources of capital to enhance broadcast offerings and strengthen competition

Enforced the Rules

- \$48M Consent Decree imposed largest civil penalty ever on broadcaster
- 106 Political File Consent Decrees and Compliance Plans to ensure adherence to the Act
- Retransmission Consent Good Faith Negotiations violations led to first NAL & maximum forfeitures

- 178 Commission Items adopted
- 54 Meeting Presentations
- 1,000 + increase in stations licensed
- 68,000 applications processed
- 987 TV Stations Repacked
