Dear Acting Chairwoman Rosenworcel:

Over the past year, the coronavirus has taken a heavy toll on the U.S. economy and on Americans' daily lives. Stay-at-home orders have made closing the digital divide all the more urgent as Americans now depend more on the internet to engage economically and socially.

I welcome the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC) ongoing work to keep Americans connected amid this pandemic, particularly in rural and underserved communities. As I evaluate the Universal Service Fund (USF) for the upcoming congressional session, I am requesting information regarding the full funding capabilities that the FCC has at its disposal.

Please provide a detailed status of funds report for all USF accounts, including but not limited to the Connect America Fund (CAF), Lifeline Program for Low-Income Consumers, E-Rate - Schools & Libraries Program, and the Rural Health Care Program. This report should clearly identify the amount of funds currently available, committed, and obligated. For obligated funds, please detail all open obligations, including partial obligations, regardless of the fiscal year in which they were appropriated or obligated. I request that this report be made available to my staff no later than March 9, 2021.
