Special Temporary Authority

Intelsat License LLC, as debtor-in-possession, requests special temporary authority for an additional 180 days to continue to operate Galaxy 11's Ku-band beams at the 93.1° W.L. orbital location over a new coverage area in the 10.95-11.2 GHz and 11.7-12.2 GHz (space-to-Earth), and 13.75-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands. Galaxy 11 provides fixed-satellite service from the 93.1° W.L. orbital location.
