Upon consideration of the motion for stay pending appeal and the responses thereto, it is

ORDERED that the motion for stay be denied. Appellant has not satisfied the stringent requirements for a stay pending appeal. See *Nken v. Holder*, 556 U.S. 418, 434 (2009); D.C. Circuit Handbook of Practice and Internal Procedures 33 (2021). It is

FURTHER ORDERED, on the court's own motion, that the Clerk amend the case caption to identify Chinese Voice of Golden City as the appellant, the Federal Communications Commission as the appellee, and Silver State Broadcasting, LLC, as an intervenor for appellee. Though styled as a petition for review, this action was brought under 47 U.S.C. § 402(b), which governs "appeals" from certain orders of the Commission, and thus the petition is properly treated as a notice of appeal.
