Special Temporary Authority

Intelsat License LLC requests special temporary authority for an additional period of 180 days to operate Intelsat 10 at the 177.8° E.L. orbital location using the 3700-4200 MHz, 11.45-11.7 GHz, 12.25-12.75 GHz (space-to-Earth) and 5925-6425 MHz and 14.0-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands. Intelsat also requests to operate telemetry, tracking, and command for Intelsat 10 at 177.8° E.L. using the following center frequencies: 11699.0 MHz, 12747.5 MHz, 12748.5 MHz, and 12749.5 MHz (space-to-Earth); and 14000.5 MHz and 14499.5 MHz (Earth-to-space).
