This is important because broadband is an essential service that every household, business, and community needs to fully participate in modern civic and commercial life. I appreciate that you understand this and share our goal of connecting everyone across the country to affordable and reliable high-speed internet service.

On January 27, 2022, the Federal Communications Commission unanimously adopted a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking seeking public comment on these broadband information labels. As part of this effort, we sought public comment on how they can advance equity in the provision of access to digital communications services and products for all people of the United States, without discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, or disability. Your letter will be entered into the record of the proceeding and will be considered as staff develops recommendations as we proceed to implement this part of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act.

In addition to the rulemaking, the agency is holding public hearings on the importance of developing these broadband labels. The first hearing was held on March 11, 2022, and featured remarks from Dr. Margaret Nygren from the American Association on Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities. Dr. Nygren emphasized the importance of making the information featured on the proposed broadband labels available in multiple languages. [You can access the footage from that hearing here](#). Additional public hearings are tentatively scheduled for April 7 and 27, 2022, and will focus on exploring what content is most valuable to consumers, and best practices for format and location of broadband labels. I encourage you and your constituents to watch and participate.
