Modification

Intelsat License LLC seeks modification of the license for Intelsat 17 by extending the license term of the space station to January 31, 2024. Intelsat 17 operates at the 91.0° W.L. orbital location in the fixed-satellite service, using the 5925-6425 MHz and 14.0-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space), and 3700-4200 MHz and 11.7-12.2 GHz (space-to-Earth) frequency bands.
