Umbra Lab, Inc. seeks modification of its license to change the deployment altitude range and the operational altitude range for its non-geostationary orbit constellation. Specifically, Umbra proposes to: (1) change the operational altitude range from 565 km +/- 30 km to 517 km +/- 30 km; and (2) change the deployment altitude range from 550 km +/- 25 km to 525 km +/- 25 km.

Modification to PDR/PPL

On April 13, 2022, Avanti Hylas 2 Ltd. (Avanti) underwent a change in ownership as a result of a reorganization conducted pursuant to the bankruptcy laws of the United Kingdom. Under the reorganization, Avanti became a wholly owned indirect subsidiary of Plate Newco 1 Limited, a United Kingdom limited company in which HPS Investment Partners LLC and Solus Alternative Asset Management LP each hold an approximate 42% interest.

Pursuant to Section 25.137(g) of the Commission's rules, the Satellite Division seeks comment on whether this transaction affects any of the considerations made when the Avanti HYLAS-4 space station was granted U. S. market entry.
