Viasat, Inc. requests a 60-day extension of the launch and operation milestone for the ViaSat-3 space station, until July 31, 2023. ViaSat-3 is planned to operate at the 88.9° W.L. orbital location using the 17.7-18.3 GHz, 18.3-19.3 GHz, 19.3-19.4 GHz, and 19.6-19.7 GHz (space-to-Earth); and 27.5-28.1, 28.1-29.1 GHz, and 29.25-29.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands.
