

Carr Statement on Senate Confirmations

WASHINGTON, D.C., September 30, 2023—Today, the United States Senate unanimously confirmed Commissioner Brendan Carr and Commissioner Geoffrey Starks to new, five-year terms on the FCC. Commissioner Carr issued the following statement:
