 Special Temporary Authority

Space Exploration Holdings, LLC

Space Exploration Holdings, LLC requests special temporary authority for an additional period of 180 days to permit continued communications between SpaceX first-generation Starlink satellites and U.S. earth stations located at latitudes above 53 degrees at elevations of no less than 10 degrees. Specifically, SpaceX seeks continued authorization to adjust the minimum elevation angle from 25 degrees to 10 degrees at latitudes above 53 degrees for communications in the 10.7-12.7 GHz (space-to-Earth) and 14.0-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands.
