Thank you for your letter regarding the pending application involving Audacy License, LLC. While it is longstanding practice that the Federal Communications Commission not comment on transactions before us, I can share that, pursuant to a bankruptcy court approved reorganization plan, the Media Bureau received Audacy's long form license assignment application on March 15, 2024. The Bureau placed the application on Public Notice on March 21, 2024. This Public Notice started a 30-day period for interested parties to file comments or Petitions to Deny the application, and the Media Research Center filed a Petition to Deny on April 22, 2024. The Bureau staff will review the record and decide if the transfer is in the public interest pursuant to Section 310(d) of the Communications Act. A copy of your letter will be placed into the record of the proceeding.
