Application for Section 325 (c) renewal permit of Uniradio Corp ("Uniradio") to deliver Spanish language sports programs and baseball games to Mexican radio station XEMO-AM, Tijuana, Mexico ("Station"). The station operates on $860~\mathrm{kHz}$ with an authorized power of $10.0~\mathrm{kW}$ daytime and $7.5~\mathrm{kW}$ nighttime.
