Universal Space Network Inc. requests special temporary authority 180 days, to operate its fixed earth station in North Pole, AK, to provide telemetry, tracking, and control (TT&C) and payload data download for the six Sentinel satellites - Sentinel 1A, 1B, 2A, 2B, 3A, and 3B at the 2075.6504 MHz (Earth-to-space), and 2254.1 MHz and 8095 MHz (space-to-Earth) center frequencies.
