Impulse Space, Inc.

Impulse Space Inc. requests authority to launch and operate one non-geostationary orbit space station, to be known as Impulse-3, that would deploy up to four customer satellites and conduct space tug and hosted payload demonstrations.

- Initial deployment at 510 km (\pm 20 km) with an inclination of 97.5 deg (\pm 2.0 deg)
- Operations between 175km and 1600 km with an inclination of 97.5 deg (\pm 2.0 deg)
- 2025-2110 MHz (Earth-to-space) – SRS, SOS, TT&C
- 8450-8500 MHz (space-to-Earth) – SRS, SOS, TT&C
