Impulse Space, Inc.

Impulse Space, Inc. requests authority to deploy and operate NGSO satellite Impulse-4 in the Space Operation Service and Space Research Service. Impulse-4 will maneuver between a series of orbits at an inclination of 88 degrees +/- 2 degrees with perigees between 200 +/- 25 km and 800 +/- 50 km and apogees between 350 +/- 25 km and 1450 +/- 150 km.

Impulse Space seeks authority to operate in the following frequencies:

- 2025-2110 MHz (Earth-to-Space)
- 8450-8500 MHz (space-to-Earth)
