ERRATUM

SPACE BUREAU SEEKS COMMENT ON GSO REFERENCE LINKS

SB Docket No. 25-157

On May 12, 2026, the Space Bureau released a Public Notice, DA 26-467, in the above captioned proceeding. This Erratum amends the Public Notice as indicated below:

1. On the first page, correct the Comment and Reply Comment Date to read as follows:

Comment Date: 30 days after publication in the Federal Register

Reply Comment Date: 45 days after publication in the Federal Register

2. Add new footnote 7 to read as follows; the remaining footnotes are renumbered accordingly.

“7 The actions in this Public Notice have not changed, or proposed to change, our Final Regulatory Flexibility Analysis (FRFA), which was set forth in the *Order*. See *Order*, Appx. C. Thus, no supplemental FRFA is necessary. In addition, the action contained herein does not change, or propose to change, the information collection requirements subject to the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995 (“PRA”), Public Law 104-13, contained in the *Order*. As a result, no new submission to the Office of Management and Budget is necessary to comply with the PRA requirements.”

3. On page 3, below second to last paragraph, add a new paragraph to read as follows:

“*Providing Accountability Through Transparency Act*. Consistent with the Providing Accountability Through Transparency Act, Public Law 118-9, a summary of this document will be available on <https://www.fcc.gov/proposed-rulemaking>. 5 U.S.C. § 553(b)(4). The Providing Accountability Through Transparency Act, Pub. L. No. 118-9 (2023), amended Section 553(b) of the Administrative Procedure Act.”
