Space Logistics LLC

Space Logistics, LLC requests special temporary authority for an additional period of 180 days to perform telemetry, tracking, and command operations (TT&C) to (1) undock the MEV-1 spacecraft from the Optus D3 space station at the 156°E.L. orbital location; (2) drift the MEV-1 spacecraft from the 156° E.L. orbital location to the 141° W.L. orbital location; and (3) stationkeep MEV-1 at the 141° W.L. orbital location.

Space Logistics operates in the following bands:

- 4000-4200 MHz (Earth-to-space) (TT&C)
- 5925-6425 MHz (space-to-Earth) (TT&C)
