ERRATUM

By the Chief, Wireline Competition Bureau:

On August 14, 2026, the Commission released the 2026 Section 706 Report, FCC 26-55, in the above captioned proceeding. This Erratum corrects and updates a statistic, as described below:

1. In paragraph 131, the fifth sentence “Starlink alone has launched over 2,300 satellites between mid-2024 and mid-2025 and has now deployed more than 7,800 satellites—a worldwide network already with over 7 million American subscribers” is corrected to read as follows:

“Starlink alone has reported a total of over 10,200 on-orbit broadband and mobile satellites and has grown its global subscriber base from 6 million to 12 million between June 30, 2025 and June 30, 2026.”

2. Footnote 370 is corrected to read as follows:
