ORDER

For reasons of judicial and administrative effectiveness, the Presiding Judge hereby approves electronic filing of pleadings by counsel in this proceeding.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that, effective **October 1, 2012**, parties to this proceeding are authorized to file pleadings through the FCC Secretary's Electronic Comment Filing System – ECFS.

In furtherance of ensuring a seamless transition and to assist the parties' compliance, the following guidelines are instituted:¹

- (1) Counsel for each party shall consult the Secretary's guidelines for electronic filing in docketed proceedings as found on the Secretary's page of the FCC website.
- (2) After filing the document electronically, counsel shall retain the electronic proof of filing receipt.
- (3) Counsel shall e-mail a courtesy copy of the electronically filed document to the Presiding Judge that includes a copy of the proof of filing receipt. Courtesy copies shall also be sent to Mary Gosse and Austin Randazzo.²

Counsel are reminded that pleadings filed with the Secretary's Office must be addressed correctly in order to be processed by that Office. Thus, all filed pleadings must have a "By line" which appears under the caption and above the title of the pleading. The "By line" should appear as follows:

The Office of Administrative Law Judges is not responsible for monitoring EDOCS/ECFS system for documents that are filed in this proceeding.

¹ These guidelines may later be modified for good reason and suggestions may be offered informally *via* e-mail after full consultation among the parties, including the Enforcement Bureau.

² Failure to provide the Presiding Judge and staff with the necessary timely courtesy copy of the filed pleadings and proof of filing receipt causes unneeded delay in the consideration and processing of the item.

³ Courtesy copies of the *Order* sent by e-mail on issuance to each counsel and to Mr. Havens. Counsel for Mr. Havens who have appeared in this case but who seek to withdraw as counsel shall continue to receive e-mail notices of the Presiding Judge's rulings until (1) an individual attorney files and serves a request to no longer be served; or (2) Mr. Havens retains new counsel who represents all Havens' entities, and who is serving for the duration.
