For reasons of judicial and administrative effectiveness, the Presiding Judge hereby approves electronic filing of pleadings by counsel in this proceeding.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that, effective October 1, 2012, parties to this proceeding are authorized to file pleadings through the FCC Secretary's Electronic Comment Filing System – ECFS.

In furtherance of ensuring a seamless transition and to assist the parties' compliance, the following guidelines are instituted:¹
