
**ORDER**

It has been quite some time since either Game Show Network, LLC (“GSN”) or Cablevision Systems Corporation (“Cablevision”) apprised the Presiding Judge of the status of their hearing preparations. In the interest of moving this case forward in a timely manner, **IT IS ORDERED** that GSN and Cablevision **SHALL** submit, jointly if possible, a status report **on or before December 6, 2013** that describes the actions currently being taken to prepare for hearing and includes estimates as to when the parties will be prepared to propose a new hearing date. If GSN and Cablevision indicate in their status reports that they are prepared to propose a new hearing date, **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the parties include, jointly if possible, a proposed hearing calendar with their reports.
