ORDER

On May 27, 2014, the Presiding Judge issued *Order*, FCC 14M-16, scheduling a prehearing conference on June 24, 2014 at 10:00 am. Counsel for Patrick Sullivan and Lake Broadcasting, Inc. (“applicants”) filed a timely Notice of Appearance on June 6, 2014. The Enforcement Bureau (“Bureau”) will also appear and attend.

In order to facilitate the conference, counsel for the applicants and the Bureau shall be prepared to confer as to the following:


1. Descriptions of the evidence each party intends to present on the issues designated in the Hearing Designation Order,¹ including evidence of Mr. Michael S. Rice’s rehabilitation as to the behavior for which he was convicted, and as to his reliability as to truthfulness.
2. Matters to which counsel wish to stipulate.
3. Preliminary identification of witnesses each intends to present at hearing. The Presiding Judge does not permit witnesses to testify at the hearing that have not been deposed, unless deposing is waived. Expert witnesses must provide a written report pursuant to Fed.R.Civ.P. 26(a)(2)(B). Counsel may also suggest any limitations they wish to set on the number or type of witnesses.
4. Descriptions of other documents intended to be offered at hearing.

5. The number of character letters to be submitted as evidence of Mr. Rice's good character. Unless ordered, character letters' authors shall not be deposed.
6. Unless objected to by any party,² the Presiding Judge requests a copy of the letter from Dr. Wayne A. Stillings, which was referenced in the Hearing Designation Order.³
7. Estimates of the time to complete document and deposition discovery.
8. A procedural schedule, including scheduling of document requests, depositions, interrogatories, and requests to admit.
9. A date for hearing.
10. The agreement of parties to permit the electronic filing of pleadings.
11. Any other preparation or trial business counsel wishes to raise.
