The parties have agreed to procedural and trial dates. Their agreed schedule takes into account witness availability and the need to complete additional prehearing tasks.

The trial shall start at 10:30 a.m. on June 1, 2015. Thereafter, the start time shall be 10:00 a.m. Sessions are anticipated to end at or about 5:00 p.m., subject to completion of the testimony of any witness still on the stand. Witnesses that begin their testimony in the afternoon will be accommodated to permit their testimony to be concluded on the same day if possible. Trial days shall extend from Monday, June 1 to Thursday, June 4 for the first week, and shall be resumed on Tuesday, June 9 for the second week. It is expected that all testimony should be completed by Friday, June 12.

Lunch will be taken from 12:15 to 1:30 p.m. Morning and afternoon breaks of 15 minutes duration will also be taken at convenient times.

The schedule shall be:

March 20	End of fact and expert deposition period.
April 21	Completed direct case document exhibits and deposition designations exchanged noon.
April 28	Completed trial briefs, written direct testimony, and deposition counter-designations exchanged by noon.
May 8	Objections filed to Completed direct case exhibits, written testimony, and/or deposition designation and counter-designations.


