**ORDER**

Pursuant to *Order*, FCC 16M-15, the parties filed a Joint Status Report (“JSR”) on April 20, 2016. The JSR reflects that Dr. Kimberly Weitzl, expert psychologist for the Enforcement Bureau (“EB”), completed her exam of Mr. Michael Rice on December 2, 2015; that Dr. Weitzl completed her written report in early March 2016; that EB provided copies of Dr. Weitzl’s written report along with a written statement by Mr. Rice’s Parole Officer, Tammy Gremminger, to counsel for Lake Broadcasting on March 21, 2016; and that Lake Broadcasting had filed a Motion to Reject Exhibits, Halt Depositions, and Require a New Evaluation of Michael Rice or Grant Summary Decision (“Lake Broadcasting’s Motion”) on April 14, 2016.

Accompanying Lake Broadcasting’s Motion was a Summary Assessment of the Psychological Report, dated April 7, 2016, that was prepared by Duncan-Hively Psychological Services. The Assessment seriously questions Dr. Weitzl’s examination and report, and raises other questions of Dr. Weitzl’s possible bias against pedophilia offenders, and found a tendency to support police enforcers in her methodology. These questions of possible expert bias are to be addressed as soon as possible.


