## **MEMORANDUM OPINION & ORDER**

The Hearing Designation Order (*HDO*)<sup>1</sup> references several letters between the renewal applicant, William F. Crowell (Crowell), and W. Riley Hollingsworth (Hollingsworth), former Special Counsel for the Enforcement Bureau. The referenced letters include, in chronological order:

- 1. August 21, 2000 letter from Hollingsworth to Crowell;
- 2. November 28, 2000 letter from Hollingsworth to Crowell;
- 3. May 15, 2006 letter from Hollingsworth to Crowell;
- 4. June 10, 2006 letter from Crowell to Hollingsworth;
- 5. September 20, 2006 letter from Hollingsworth to Crowell;
- 6. April 3, 2007 letter from Hollingsworth to Crowell.

The Presiding Judge was not furnished copies of any of the Hollingsworth-Crowell correspondence. The Bureau has represented that it has some, though not all, of the letters. None of these letters, which are cited in the *HDO*, appear in the official record for this proceeding. Since the Hollingsworth-Crowell letters were cited in the *HDO*, and also were cited as evidence by Crowell in certain pleadings, this omission must be corrected.

Therefore, the parties shall file with the Commission the letters identified above that they have in their possession. Such filings shall be made via the Commission's Electronic Comment
