**ORDER**



1. By motion filed on July 22, 2019, Entertainment Media Trust, Dennis J. Watkins, Trustee (EMT), seeks additional time to respond to the Requests for Admission of Facts served on it by the Enforcement Bureau in this proceeding.<sup>1</sup> The Enforcement Bureau's pleading, dated July 16, 2019, requests a response within 10 days pursuant to section 1.246 of the Commission's rules, 47 CFR § 1.246, i.e., July 26, 2019.<sup>2</sup> EMT filed a Request for Admissions of the Bureau on the same date but did not specify a response time.<sup>3</sup>

2. EMT asks for a five-day extension of time, until July 31, 2019, to file its response given the extensive list of admissions sought by the Bureau. Neither the Bureau nor Petitioner Mark Kern objects to this request. The Presiding Judge finds that the brief extension requested is reasonable, and that making all responses to requests for admission due by the same date is fair, reasonable, and consistent with section 1.246 of the Commission's rules. Accordingly, EMT's Motion for Extension of Time IS GRANTED. IT IS ORDERED that both EMT's response to the Enforcement Bureau's Requests for Admission of Facts and the Bureau's response to EMT's Request for Admissions are due on or before **July 31, 2019**.
